

Can I go abroad if I do a Cog Sci major?

Yes, definitely. You need to plan carefully because courses that count toward the major may not be available in your semester abroad. In that case, use your courses abroad to fulfill other requirements (like for CAS Humanities or Social Science distribution) or a minor, etc., and leave room in your semesters at Lehigh for the major courses.

It is easier to fit everything in if you are doing the B.A., but it can be possible for the B.S. with careful planning (and possibly some summer classes).

Sometimes there *are* courses relevant for the Cog Sci major available abroad. The only way to know is to figure out what programs you're interested in and look at their offerings.

How do I get courses abroad approved for transfer for the Cog Sci major?

All courses are reviewed for transfer by the department that offers the same topic at Lehigh. So, if you want to transfer a Philosophy course, you need to take it to the Philosophy Department. If you want to transfer a Biology course, you need to take it to the Biology Department.

If that department approves it as equivalent to a Lehigh course that is in our major, then it will count in the major.

Your major adviser cannot approve courses for transfer to Lehigh unless it is for transfer as an actual COGS course (COGS 007 or COGS 140).
